

East Coast Gas System Direction Revocation Notice

Reference: National Gas Rules (NGR), Part 27, Division 4, Exercise of east coast gas system reliability and supply adequacy functions

Under rule 697 of the NGR, AEMO is providing notice that it has revoked the east coast gas system direction given under NGR, Part 27, Division 5, as described in the ECGS Direction Notice published on 19 March 2024. The direction related to the Queensland Gas Pipeline failure event Risk or Threat Notice published at 14:12 AEST 5 March 2024.

AEMO is required to publish a notice of revocation if an ECGS direction relating to the notice is revoked. AEMO is required to publish this notice of revocation with the following information in regard to the exercise of the direction function:

(a) The reason for the revocation: the Queensland Gas Pipeline (QGP) facility operator have advised AEMO of the restoration of the pipeline to its full firm contracted capacity, and AEMO have determined that the direction is not required to mitigate the relevant identified threat.

The ECGS direction was revoked with effect from 10 December 2024.

AEMO published a preliminary-post intervention report on 7 May 2024, and as required under rule 698 will publish a final report within 4 months of the direction revocation.
